Travel to Concord, NH by air, train and bus

By air:

Arrive at Logan Airport.

Take Concord Coach bus, which has many buses running each day that pick up at each airport terminal at the Scheduled Bus location; look for the Scheduled Bus sign just outside of baggage claim. <https://concordcoachlines.com/>

Arrive at Manchester Airport.

There is one daily Greyhound bus to Concord NH, which leaves from the front door of the one Manchester Airport terminal at 2:05pm ET, <https://www.greyhound.com/>
OR Take Lyft, Uber or rental car on I-293N to I-93N North to Concord.

By train:

Arrive at South Station in Boston. Take Concord Coach bus, which has many buses running each day from South Station. <https://concordcoachlines.com/>

By Car:

Approximate drive times and distances from major hubs include:

- **Boston, MA:** 1 hour 15 minutes (*70 miles via I-93 N*)
- **Portland, ME:** 2 hours (*85 miles via I-95 S and NH-4 W*)
- **Providence, RI:** 2 hours 10 minutes (*111 miles via I-95 N and I-93 N*)
- **New York City, NY:** 5 hours (*250 miles via I-95 N and I-93 N*)

Driving Directions to the Unitarian-Universalist Church of Concord, NH:

1. Find your way to Concord, NH via I-93 North.
2. Take Exit 11 to I-89 North.
3. Take Exit 2 to Clinton St.
4. Take a right onto Clinton St. and travel for .7 miles.
5. Take a left onto Langley Parkway.
6. At the next light, take a left onto Pleasant St.
7. The church is the second building on the right. The entrance comes up fast just after the back entrance to Concord Orthopedics! To park, continue straight past the church building on your left and proceed to the back parking lot.

Uber and Lyft are available in Concord, NH.

Land and environment



The Unitarian-Universalist Church of Concord is located on traditional homelands of the Pennacook Abenaki People past and present. Concord Nh is situated on the Merrimack River. Merrimack means "swift-running water" or "place of the swift current" in the Algonquian language, specifically from the Abenaki word "Merrimake."

We ask you to join us in acknowledging and honoring with gratitude the land, air, water, all the more-than-human kin and the people who have stewarded this land for generations.

Below are some images from the land that we will practice on, surrounding the church, as well as information about the hiking trails available on and beyond the church's land.

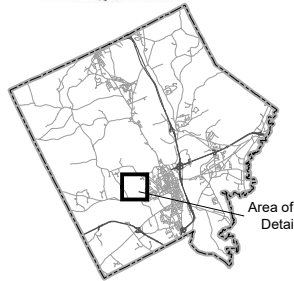


Winant Park Trails

Area of Detail

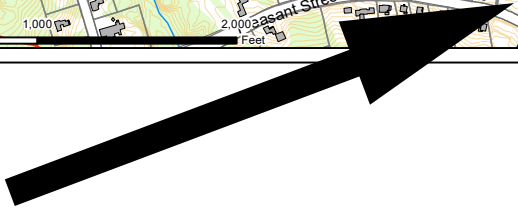
